

100% SMOKEFREE U.S. AIRPORTS*April 1, 2008*

In addition to protecting the health of airport employees and patrons, smokefree indoor air policies also benefit airports in other ways. Smokefree airports save money that would otherwise be spent paying for the expensive ventilation equipment, messy filters, and extensive maintenance associated with tobacco industry "ventilation" programs. Furthermore, smokefree airports save precious terminal space, as indoor smoking areas can be used to provide more shops, restaurants, and other airport amenities. By adopting 100% smokefree indoor air policies, airports choose to save money, space, and most importantly, people's lives.

Below is a **partial** list of U.S. airports that are 100% smokefree indoors, including airline clubs, passenger terminals and non-public work areas. **There are now at least 136 smokefree airports**, and the list is growing all the time.
