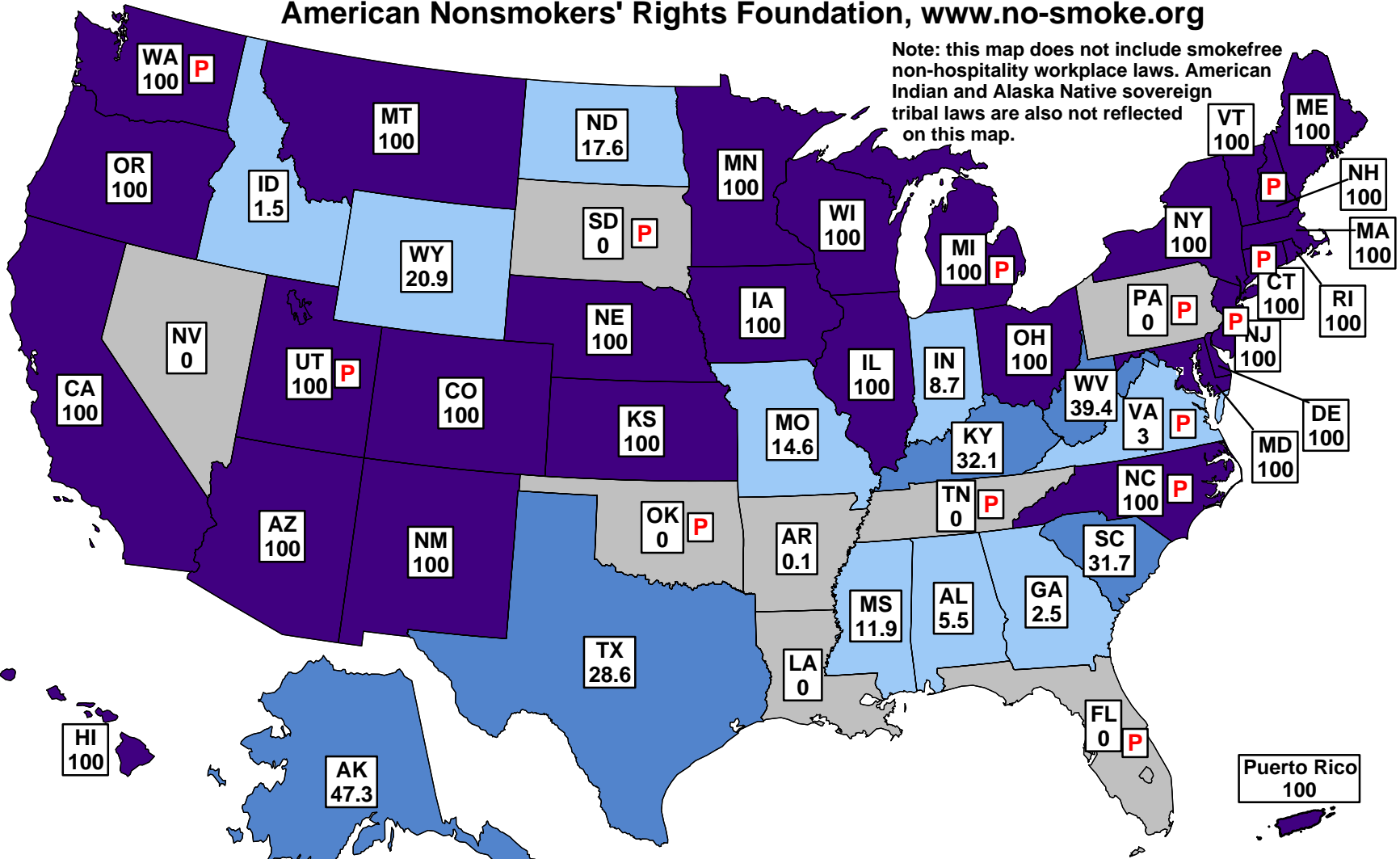


Percent of Population Covered by 100% Smokefree Restaurant AND Bar Laws in effect as of July 5, 2010

100% Smokefree Restaurants AND Bars: Municipalities with ordinances or regulations that do not allow smoking in attached bars or separately ventilated rooms and do not have size exemptions.

South Dakota enacted a 100% smokefree restaurant, bar, and gaming facilities law, which was scheduled to go into effect on July 1, 2009, but which has been suspended by a referendum placing the law on the ballot in November 2010, and which will not go into effect unless approved by the voters.

U.S. Virgin Islands enacted a 100% smokefree law for all workplaces, restaurants, bars and gaming, which is scheduled to go into effect on May 10, 2011.
