ABOUT US

ANR is the leading national lobbying organization dedicated to nonsmokers' rights, with more than 30 years of experience eliminating secondhand smoke exposure. ANR's activities center around efforts to enact legislation to protect nonsmokers in the workplace and enclosed public places. ANR also started the fight against preemptive state laws and advocates for local control.

Our staff provides technical assistance and support to advocates, elected officials, public health professionals, and the media about secondhand smoke, smokefree air policies, and tobacco industry interference.

SECONDHAND SMOKE

Secondhand smoke is a cause of serious disease and death, including heart disease, heart attacks, cancer, and respiratory illnesses, such as asthma. It is the third leading cause of preventable death in the United States, accounting for 53,000 deaths in nonsmokers every year, according to the National Cancer Institute. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention warns people at risk of heart disease to avoid all environments that allow indoor smoking. People have the right to work in places free from this known health hazard.



SMOKEFREE INDOOR AIR

As of April 1, 2008, more than 12,700 municipalities and 27 states are covered by a 100% smokefree state law, reaffirming that smokefree air is a mainstream idea whose time has come. More than 60% of the U.S. population now lives in a community with at least one 100% smokefree provision, thanks to the hard work of ANR members and smokefree advocates.

LOOKING AHEAD

Enormous smokefree accomplishments have been achieved over the past three decades, but approximately one-third of the U.S. population is still breathing secondhand smoke in workplaces and public places. And tobacco companies and their allies continue to undermine smokefree air efforts. Our work is not over until everyone's right to breathe clean, smokefree indoor air has been realized.
