

Smoking Policies at NFL Stadiums

Arizona Cardinals - University of Phoenix Stadium

In accordance with the Smoke-Free Arizona Act, University of Phoenix Stadium is a non-smoking facility. There are three designated smoking locations on the main concourse located beyond the Gate 2 exterior gate and outside the exit doors at Sections 102 and 137. Fans on the Club level, Loft corridor and terrace level can proceed to the designated smoking locations on the north ramp. Please remember to keep the north ramp walk aisles clear for other fans and smoke only in the designated areas. Fans outside the stadium are reminded that they must be at least 20 feet away from any stadium entrance to smoke. Fans that do not comply with the smoking policy inside the stadium are subject to ejection.

Atlanta Falcons – Georgia Dome

For the comfort and health of all fans, the Georgia Dome is a smoke-free environment. There is no smoking allowed in the facility.

Smoking is permitted outside of all entry gates. If you wish to smoke while at a Falcons game, pick up a wristband at a Dome Service Center and proceed outside to the designated smoking areas. You must present your wristband and your ticket to re-enter the Georgia Dome.

Individuals who violate the smoke-free policy will be asked to leave the Georgia Dome.

Baltimore Ravens - M&T Bank Stadium

For the health and comfort of Ravens guests and stadium employees, smoking is not permitted in any of the seating areas, any restroom or on suite balconies. Smoking is prohibited on the enclosed Club Level concourse and on the Club Level bridges. Club Level guests and Suite guests may smoke on ramps and stairs outside the Club Level and Suite Levels. Smoking is prohibited in the enclosed Suite Levels including hallways, corridors and the suites themselves. Smoking is permitted on the upper level concourse and the following designated areas on the lower concourse:

Directly inside of Gates A, B, C and D beginning at kickoff within marked areas.

Next to the Northwest ramp area opposite of section 148 beginning at gate opening time.

Inside the exit gate opposite of section 142 beginning at gate opening time.

Inside the exit gate opposite of section 138 beginning at gate opening time.

Inside the Press entry gate opposite of section 126 beginning at gate opening time.

Inside the gate opposite section 105 beginning at kickoff.

Guests who fail to comply with the policy after appropriate warnings may be subject to ejection.

Buffalo Bills – Ralph Wilson Stadium

Erie County Local Laws prohibit smoking within the confines of Ralph Wilson Stadium including concourses, bathrooms, concession areas, suite and club areas, and all seating areas. Smoking is permitted only in the clearly defined designated smoking areas adjacent to the outer perimeter fence. Smoking in areas of the stadium not designated as a smoking area may result in the issuance of an appearance ticket. Violations of the Local Law are punishable by a civil penalty and may result in a fine.

Carolina Panthers – Bank of America Stadium

Smoking is prohibited in the seating bowl and all areas of the stadium. Fans who fail to comply with this policy after the appropriate warning will be ejected from the stadium.

Chicago Bears – Soldier Field

The Smoke-Free Illinois Act prohibits smoking in Soldier Field for Bears games. In consideration of the comfort of all ticket holders, we ask for your cooperation. There are no designated smoking areas inside the stadium, and re-entry is prohibited. The smoking policy will be strictly enforced. First time violators of the smoking policy will be asked to exchange their ticket for a “Smoking Violation Ticket”. Any guest refusing to exchange their ticket will be ejected from the stadium. If a guest with a smoking violation ticket is then smoking in the stadium for a second time, he or she will be ejected. Repeated violations can result in the forfeiting of season ticket privileges.

Cincinnati Bengals – Paul Brown Stadium

Paul Brown Stadium is a smoke-free facility. As a result of recent legislation, smoking is no longer permitted in any public place, including all areas of Paul Brown Stadium. Your cooperation in following this policy is appreciated. Guests who fail to comply with the policy after appropriate warnings may be subject to ejection from Paul Brown Stadium.

Cleveland Browns - Cleveland Browns Stadium

In compliance with Chapter 3794 of the Ohio Revised Code, smoking is prohibited in Cleveland Browns Stadium.

Dallas Cowboys – Cowboys Stadium

In accordance with City of Arlington regulations, smoking is prohibited in all areas of the stadium. Guests wishing to smoke may do so only in designated smoking areas. Designated smoking areas are in the following locations:

East and West plazas (at least 50 feet from the stadium entrance)
Outside Entries A, E, F, & K (Club & Suite guests only)

Violators of this policy may be ejected from the stadium. All Season Ticket Holders are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their guests and/or persons using their tickets.

Denver Broncos - INVESCO Field at Mile High

Smoking is not permitted on the concourses or in any seating or enclosed areas of INVESCO Field at Mile High. Guests may smoke in designated smoking areas only, located adjacent to gates on the Lower Concourse (Level 1) and in designated ramp areas on other levels. Please note the designation of smoking areas by the location of ashtrays and smoking area signage.

Detroit Lions – Ford Field

For the health and comfort of our guests, smoking is not permitted in Ford Field. Guests who fail to comply with the policy after appropriate warnings may be subject to ejection. During Lions home games, smoking is generally permitted in the following areas:

During the entire game:

Gate A - outside on the deck above the Ticket office. Enter through the Executive Entrance.

Gate E

North Patio Terrace – 2nd Level near Section 232/233 (weather permitting).

Cigar Bar – inside the North Club Lounge for Club and Suite guests only post game.

30 minutes after kick-off:

Gate C

Gate D

Gate G

Half-time only:

Gate B

Gate F

Brush Street Roll-Up doors (weather permitting).

Green Bay Packers – Lambeau Field

Effective July 5, 2010, Lambeau Field will be a smoke-free facility as required by Wisconsin State Law. This includes the Lambeau Field Atrium, Curly's Pub, stadium bowl and concourses. There will be no designated smoking areas inside Lambeau Field. Guests who fail to comply with this policy may be ejected or subject to a fine.

Houston Texans – Reliant Stadium

In consideration of the health and comfort of others, smoking is not permitted in the seating area or on the concourses. There are designated smoking terraces located on all four sides of the Field Level and the Verizon Wireless Club Level and also in each corner of the Upper Level. Please note that certain smoking terraces may be closed at times; however, alternate smoking terraces on the same level will remain open.

Indianapolis Colts – Lucas Oil Stadium

Smoking is strictly prohibited within the stadium. Smoking is permitted at any of the four (4) gates located on the exterior of the stadium. Please stay within these gates – do NOT exit. If gates are exited, re-entry into the stadium will not be allowed.

Jacksonville Jaguars - Jacksonville Municipal Stadium

A City of Jacksonville Executive Order bans smoking in the seating areas, concourses, Stadium Clubs and restrooms. Smoking is allowed only on the ramps and in designated areas of the stadium. Fans who fail to comply with this policy, after the appropriate warning, are subject to ejection from the stadium. Signs are posted throughout the stadium indicating designated or non-designated smoking areas.

Kansas City Chiefs – Arrowhead Stadium

For the comfort of all Arrowhead guests, smoking is prohibited in the seating bowl and all areas of the stadium except the designated smoking areas listed below. So that guests who smoke will not miss the game, TV's are provided in all areas except the press stairwells.

Designated smoking areas are:

- At the top of the field level end zone stairs behind sections 110 and 128
- Designated areas at the four corner entry gates on street level
- Sections of the upper sideline level bars
- Press level exterior stairwells.

Fans who fail to comply with this policy after a warning are subject to ejection from the stadium and potential revocation of tickets.

Miami Dolphins – Land Shark Stadium

Smoking is only permitted on the designated areas on the ramps, at the Smirnoff Bars and the corners of the expanded concourses on the south and north sides of the stadium on the 100 level as indicated by the smoking signs. NO smoking is permitted in the seating bowl or other areas of the facility.

Minnesota Vikings – Mall of America Field

In accordance with the Minnesota Indoor Clean Air Act, there is no smoking at Mall of America Field. Smoking is permitted in the outer gate areas between the turnstiles and revolving doors only.

New England Patriots – Gillette Stadium

Smoking is permitted only on designated stadium ramps.

New Orleans Saints – Superdome

As a valued Saints patron, we want you to be aware that the Louisiana Legislature recently passed legislation making the entire Superdome a smoke-free facility.

Smoking is not permitted anywhere inside the Superdome.

If you wish to smoke, designated smoking areas have been established outside Gates B, D, F, H on the Plaza (100) Level. Be sure to retain your portion of the game-ticket for re-entry. To facilitate access for patrons in the Loge and Terrace Levels, the escalators will be available in both directions after the crowd has entered.

The interior lobby areas will no longer be available for smoking.

We appreciate your cooperation in providing a clean air environment for all of our fans.

New York Giants – Meadowlands Stadium

Smoking is prohibited throughout the stadium in accordance with state law.

New York Jets - Meadowlands Stadium

Smoking is prohibited throughout the stadium in accordance with state law.

Oakland Raiders – Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum

Smoking is prohibited throughout the stadium, pursuant to the Oakland Municipal Code.

Philadelphia Eagles – Lincoln Financial Field

The City Ordinance of Philadelphia prohibits smoking in public places and workplaces, including sports facilities. At Lincoln Financial Field, smoking is prohibited in all areas of the stadium. Designated smoking areas are available in the following locations.

HeadHouse Plaza

Outside the West Gate across from Section 101

Outside the south of the stadium across from Section 113
Outside each Club and Suite entry (Club & Suite Guests only)

Violators of this policy may be ejected from the stadium. *All Season Ticket Holders are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their Guests and/or persons using their tickets.*

Pittsburgh Steelers – Heinz Field

Smoking is not permitted in the seating bowl, restrooms, Coca-Cola Great Hall, clubs, or Luxury Suites. Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas, concourses, and ramps.

Saint Louis Rams – Edward Jones Dome

The Edward Jones Dome is a non-smoking facility. During Rams football games, guests may leave and re-enter the building through the available main entries to smoke outdoors. Guests leaving the dome to smoke are not permitted to take alcoholic beverages outside.

San Diego Chargers - Qualcomm Stadium

The stadium is 100% smoke free. Smoking in the stadium is a violation of The City of San Diego's Municipal Code and may result in ejection or citation.

San Francisco 49ers – Candlestick Park

Smoking at Candlestick Park is restricted to designated locations. Per the March 2010 amendment of the San Francisco Health Code (Article 19F, Section 1009.22[b]), smoking is only permitted on ramps, in parking lots and in Luxury Suites. Smoking in any other location at Candlestick Park is prohibited.

Seattle Seahawks – Qwest Field

In compliance with state law (RCW 70.160), smoking is prohibited in all areas of Qwest Field and Event Center.

Tampa Bay Buccaneers – Raymond James Stadium

Smoking is prohibited in the stadium except in the following designated areas: a. Ground level - just inside each gate near the escalators; b. Main concourse - across from the concession stands in west sections 103, 108 and 118 and east sections 128, 133 and 143 along the exterior wall; c. Club - terraces of each club lounge located off of the elevator lobby and outside club ramp doors; d. Suite level terraces - on each suite level located off of the elevator lobby; e. Suites - No smoking is permitted in individual suites; f. Upper concourses - top of the ramps in each quad and across from the concession stand in west section 303, 308 and 318 and east 328, 333 and 334 along the exterior wall.

Tennessee Titans – LP Field

LP Field has a "no smoking policy" in the seating, Suite and Club areas. We have provided areas for smokers on the ramps located at each corner of LP Field. In addition to the ramps, Club patrons may use the special club verandas located at Section 303 on the West side and at Section 326 on the East side. Smoking policies are subject to applicable law.

Washington Redskins – FedExField

Smoking is not permitted in the seating areas, lower level concourse, suites, portals, tunnels or restrooms of FedExField. Guests wishing to smoke may do so on any ramp and on the open-air concourses of the Upper Level.

Smoking is prohibited on the Club Level enclosed concourse. However, Club Level guests may smoke in the Club Macanudo Cigar Bar located at Sections 306-308, outside on the patio of the Wild Goose Landing, or on any ramp. Smoking is also permitted on the Smoking Deck at the elevator tower at the Sprint Gate (Gate A) and the Bank of America Gate (Gate E).
